


## **REPORT ON THE ONLINE LOCAL SEMINAR IN LJUBLJANA**

Local seminar 3 was organized after Workshop 4 on Project-Based Learning and Practical Training of Community Interpreters and Intercultural Mediators and Workshop 5 on Evaluation and Assessment of Community Interpreters and Community Interpreters' Trainers.

The event was held on the ZOOM web application on the 15th of October 2020, from 4pm to 5:30pm. 26 people participated at the event, 7 of them identify as intercultural mediators or community interpreters and work in different regions in Slovenia, the rest were teaching staff of the University of Arts in Ljubljana and staff of the National Institute of Public Health of Slovenia. The event was organised by the National Institute of Public Health of Slovenia and promoted through the ErasmusDays platform and the European researchers' night programme.




Anja Kociper had an introduction to the event.

Mira Grabanica and Vera Haliti presented core content issues from the TRAMIG workshop in Italy (Reggio Emillia) and Greece (Thessaloniki), which was held online due to covid-19 pandemic.

The emphasis was put on intercultural mediation education programme (difficult situations where lack of trust and other issues contributed to the failure of the mediation process and how to avoid or handle such situation in a positive way) and assessment in intercultural mediator and community interpreter training.

Mira Grabanica and Vera Haliti also held a workshop on exercises from practice developed by The local health authority of Reggio Emillia and Aristotle University of Thessaloniki.
